

Financial assistance is based on documented financial need.

Through the generosity of friends of Baltimore Lutheran School, limited grants are available for families demonstrating financial need who desire their children to receive the Christian education provided by Baltimore Lutheran.

FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment will be conducting the financial need analysis for Baltimore Lutheran for the 2012-2013 school year. Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. For new students, financial aid forms should be filed during the application process, as requests cannot be considered once the school year has begun.

New Student Applicants may apply online beginning November 1, 2011, at www.factstuitionaid.com. Applications for financial aid for new students will not be accepted after February 15, 2012.

The following information is required in order for FACTS to process your application:

1. Completed application.
2. Payment of the FACTS application fee.
3. Copies of your 2010 tax forms including all supporting tax schedules.
4. Copies of your 2011 W-2 form for both you and your spouse.
5. Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, food stamps, workers' compensation, and TANF.

The BLS Tuition Assistance Committee makes decisions on the amount of financial aid awards and communicates those at the time of acceptance, as long as all required information has been verified by FACTS before that time. Recipients are notified by mail. All financial information and the identity of students seeking and receiving financial assistance is kept confidential.

All financial assistance is awarded on an annual basis.

Families must submit an application form every year to be considered for renewal of financial assistance. *Returning students must submit their request between February 1 and April 16 for the next school year.*

Congregational Support

Members of a Baltimore Lutheran School Association Congregation may be eligible for a tuition discount. Students or parents must be active members of an Association Congregation that has fulfilled the annual financial and ministry commitments to BLS. Some area churches may provide assistance for families seeking to provide a Christian education for their children.
